## RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The Tournament is open to Tamil Nadu Players only.
- FIDE Rapid Rules in force shall apply and the Swiss system will be followed.
- Time Control: Total duration – 30 minutes.
- TNSCA Player Registration: TNSCA player registration is compulsory for all Tamil Nadu players. The TNSCA Player Registration fee is Rs. 150/- for the year 2025-2026. Players/arbiters registration should be done well before the start of the event (tournament). New entrants to the field of chess are informed that TNSCA player registration is mandatory and it should be done well before participating in any tournament. To renew TNSCA player registration of existing players, please click <https://registration.tamilchess.com/>. For fresh TNSCA registration, please click <https://registration.tamilchess.com/new-register/> For fresh TNSCA registration, players are requested to keep their scanned passport-size photograph and birth certificate and a valid email address ready before the registration process. Note: Only passport-size (less than 1 MB) photographs in JPEG format should be uploaded.
- CGDCA Player Registration: Registration fee is Rs. 75/- for the year 2025 – 2026 (for Chengalpattu District players only)
- The first round will commence at 9.00 AM on 03.08.2025. The number of rounds and the round-wise schedule will be announced at the tournament venue.
- Players are requested to bring their own international chess sets (and chess clocks if, any).
- Tiebreak: The latest tiebreak system will be applied.
- The Chief Arbiter's decisions shall be final and binding on all players concerned.
- An age-proof Certificate must be produced.
- Entries close at 5.00 P.M on 01.08.2025. No entry will be entertained after 5.00 P.M. on 01.08.2025. Strictly no Spot Entries.
- Participation certificates will be awarded to all participants.
