

Rules & Regulations

- The tournament is open to Tamil Nadu students only.
- The latest FIDE rules in force shall apply, and the Swiss System will be followed. Time Control: Each 20 Minutes
- The first round will commence on 02.08.2025 (Saturday) at 9:00 a.m. The number of rounds and round-wise schedule will be announced at the tournament venue.
- Players are requested to bring their own International chess sets, and they are also requested to bring a chess clock if available.
- Tie Break: Latest AICF tie break will be applied. In case of tie, prizes will not be shared.
- The decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be final, binding on all the players concerned.
- A Certificate of Age proof must be produced at the registration desk.
- Entries close at 8.00 p.m. on 31.07.2025 (Thursday). No spot entry will be entertained.
- The organiser reserves the right of admission to the tournament.
- A Certificate of Participation will be awarded to all the participants.
- No boarding facility is arranged for the players; they are advised to make their own boarding arrangements.
