- Rule:** The tournament will be played under the latest FIDE rules.
- Mode of Tournament:** Total 8 Rounds shall be played
- Rate of Play:** 90 minutes each, plus 30 seconds increment per move from move one.
- Default time:** 30minutes

AICF player Registration: AICF Player registration is compulsory for all players. AICF Player Registration fee is Rs 300/- for the year 2025-2026. As per latest AICF regulations all AICF registrations will be accepted only through online. Players/Arbiters registration should be done well before the start of the Tournament. For renewing AICF Registration of existing players please click <http://aicf.in/players/>. For fresh AICF Registration please click <http://aicf.in/online-player-registration/>

For fresh AICF registration, players are requested to keep their scanned passport size photograph and birth certificate and a valid email address (unique) not used by any other person/player for AICF, ready before the registration process.

Note: Only passport size (less than 1MB) photograph in jpeg format should be uploaded TNSCA Player Registration: TNSCA player registration is compulsory for all Tamil Nadu players. TNSCA Player Registration fee is Rs.150/- for the year 2025-2026. Players / Arbiters registration should be done well before the start of event (Tournament). New entrants to the field of chess are informed that TNSCA players registration is mandatory and it should be done well before participating in any tournament. Chengalpattu Player Registration: Registration fee is Rs.75/- for the year 2025 – 2026 (for Chengalpattu district players only)

Tie-break: Latest AICF tie-break rules will be applied. In case of tie Prize money will not be shared

Protests: Protests, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs. 1000/- within 15 minutes of the occurrence of the incident to the appeals committee. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

Appeals Committee: An Appeals Committee comprising of five members will be formed at the players meeting. The decision of the appeals committee is final and binding on all players concerned.

Withdrawals: A player may withdraw at any stage of the event, after informing the Chief Arbiter in writing.

Wrist Watches: As per AICF regulations the wrist watches are restricted inside the playing hall in all

FIDE Rated events. Players are instructed not to wear any kind of wrist watches while playing.

PROFILE OF THE INSTITUTION

Introduction

Guru Nanak College (GNC), nestled in a lush 25-acre campus between the Raj Bhavan and IIT Madras on Guru Nanak Salai, Velachery, South Chennai, stands as a beacon of academic and sports excellence. Strategically located at the gateway to Tamil Nadu's IT Expressway, the college offers an ideal environment that blends learning, culture, and community service.

Established in 1971 by the Guru Nanak Educational Society (GNES) to commemorate the 500th Birth Anniversary of Guru Nanak Dev Ji, the college was founded under the visionary leadership of (Late) Lt. Col. G. S. Gill, the Founder President.

What began as a modest institution for men with just 450 students and three undergraduate programs has, in its Golden Jubilee Year, evolved into a co-educational, autonomous research institution with over 7,300 students, offering 26 Undergraduate, 9 Postgraduate, and 8 Ph.D. programs.

GNC is affiliated to the University of Madras, recognized by the Government of Tamil Nadu and the University Grants Commission (UGC). It functions in two shifts—Shift I (Government Aided) and Shift II (Self-Financed). The College is NAAC-accredited with 'A++' Grade (CGPA 3.68) in its third cycle, while the MBA and MCA programs are AICTE-approved and the institution is ISO 9001:2015 certified.

Community and Student Welfare

Langar (Community Kitchen):In keeping with Sikh tradition, the College provides free, nutritious meals daily to over 700 students through the Langar (community kitchen) attached to the campus Gurudwara.

Scholarships & Incentives:The College extends generous Sports Merit Scholarships, travel grants for national and international representation, and monthly stipends to deserving sportspersons. Full fee waivers and cash incentives are awarded to medal winners at national and international levels.

Sports Development

GNC's sports infrastructure and programs are among the best in South India. Renowned coaches have been appointed for cricket, volleyball, basketball, and hockey, and students train across eight state-of-the-art playfields, including the CSK-maintained lush green cricket ground.

The Shaheed Bhagat Singh Sports Academy and the Saragarhi Shooting Range—inaugurated by Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, Thiru. Udhayanidhi Stalin—serve as premier sports training hubs. The Saragarhi Shooting Range has hosted major events, including the Khelo India Games, and provides advanced coaching for school and college students.

Women's cricket has seen tremendous growth under the HCL Foundation's CSR initiative, through an MoU with the College, ensuring professional coaching, exposure, and participation opportunities.
